I'm looking forward to the year ahead as we continue to strengthen our community and guide Gates toward new growth and opportunity—both residential and commercial. My commitment remains steadfast: to keep our Town a safe, welcoming place to live and raise a family, to deliver exceptional town services, and to tackle our backlog of work orders efficiently and responsibly.

#### A Few Updates

#### .GOV Website and Email Transition

To remain compliant with state requirements, the Town of Gates has officially transitioned from .ORG to .GOV for our website and email addresses. Please note our new website: <a href="www.townofgatesny.gov">www.townofgatesny.gov</a>. All employee emails now follow the same domain structure using @townofgatesny.gov. Please update your records accordingly.

#### Leaf Collection Program

Our annual Leaf Collection Program began at the end of October and will be winding down this month. Our hardworking Highway Crews have been making multiple rounds throughout town, collecting leaves as quickly as possible. If you haven't yet raked, now's the time—our trucks will soon be converted for snow plowing and salting operations. If you don't finish in time for the Town's pickup, please remember that refuse companies will accept bagged leaves with your regular garbage collection. Should weather conditions prevent us from completing the program, we'll determine a later pickup date as needed.

#### 2026 Town Budget

The **2026 Town Budget** was officially adopted in November. While we did need to exceed the state's 2% tax cap this year, we are proud to announce that the **Town tax rate has been reduced by \$1.75**, bringing it to **\$4.55 per thousand**. Like many of you, the Town continues to face rising costs in healthcare, insurance, salaries, and general expenses. Despite these challenges, we remain committed to fiscal responsibility and are proud to have avoided any reduction in services. A special thank-you goes to our department heads and Finance Director, **Stephanie Soto**, for their hard work and dedication.

#### Santa Parade & Website Revamp

We're thrilled to announce that our beloved **Santa Parade** will return this year—so you better watch out, Santa Claus is coming to town! Tentative parade dates are **December 21st and 22nd**. #### 2026 Town and County Tax Payment Information

If your taxes are not held in escrow, you should be receiving your Town and County Tax bill by January 12<sup>th</sup>. If you have not received it, you may view a copy on Monroe County's website: <a href="https://www.monroecounty.gov">www.monroecounty.gov</a>.

-Click on 'View/Pay Taxes Online'

-Enter property address and follow prompts through to view your bill. If you are not able to view them online, please call the Town Clerks Office at 585-247-6100 ext 411 and a copy will be sent to you.

#### DO's and DON'TS for Tax Payments:

- When paying in person, the stamped copy you receive is your receipt.
- Whether paying in person or by mail with a check, please allow up to 7-10 business days for your check to clear your bank account.
- You may pay by check, cash or credit card. Checks made payable to Sarah Lobene, Tax Receiver. Credit Cards incur a processing fee. \$3.95 for Visa Debit cards and 2.45% of your total payment for every other type card. Please keep in mind that this is a third-party processing fee and not from the Town.
- You may also pay online at <u>www.monroecounty.gov</u> or via our Town Website <u>www.townofgatesny.gov</u>.
- We strongly recommend you DO NOT use Bill Pay. It takes at least 10 days for us to receive the check and they do NOT come postmarked. NYS Tax Law states we must go by Postmark date, if it is received after due date, it will be returned to you.
- First and Full Payments are due without interest by Tuesday February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
- The Drop Box will be available between the Court Office and Police Department.

**Dog Licenses**: Don't forget all dogs within the Town of Gates are required to be registered and renewed yearly. Please provide proof of spay/neuter and up to date rabies for initial registration. Updated rabies is needed for renewals. Payment may be made via cash, check or credit card. If using a credit card there will be an additional \$2.75 processing fee.



#### Planning a wedding this year?

Marriage Licenses are issued at the Town Clerks office by appointment. Please call 585-247-6100 ext. 411 a few weeks prior to your wedding to schedule appointment and go over what documents you will need to bring with you. Please remember that Marriage Licenses are not valid for 24 hours and must be used within 60 days.

# Highway Happenings: aka What did you do this Summer?

Your Town Highway Department is not just picking up brush and fixin' potholes. Sometimes we get into some very major projects. This summer, after we finished the road program, we got into a major project improving the drainage system along Burben Way.

Burben Way is a residential street in Gates off Brooks Avenue that was originally constructed in the 1920's with some homes being built in the 1940s, 50s, and 60s. It was extended in the 1960s, with the cul-de-sac and final home constructed in 2016. The roadway serves 46 single family homes. The original road was built with roadside ditches that were either piped or filed in over the years.

With climate change has come high intensity, short duration storm events that result in flooding along Burben Way, negatively impacting its residents. With the NYSDOT's planned rehabilitation of Brooks Avenue, the Town took the initiative to improve the drainage along Burben Way. Planning for the project started in 2023 for the Highway Department to install a new 18" diameter storm sewer main from the State's drainage structure at the southeast corner of Brooks Ave and Burben Way...

...to the system outlet into the Town of Chili, a distance of approximately 1,800 feet. This was along the west side of the road, keeping the existing 12" system on the east side of the road intact. Inlet basins were installed every 150 to 200 feet, and residents' sump lines were tied in. Restoration of the project was completed in mid-October, and we have been watching the weather intently. The project plans include additional improvements along the east side of the street that will occur in the future.

Part of the project also included the replacement of the barrier at the end of Ruth Ellen Way with a gate. These roads were a notorious cut through back in the day, and the barrier was erected after a child was hurt. The barrier served its purpose, but limits accessibility during emergencies. The allow aate will responders and residents another way in or out in the case of an emergency that blocks the road. It will also allow the Highway Department better access for plowing during storm events.

#### **TAX SEASON SCAMS:**

As we approach the 2025 tax deadline season, we will inevitably encounter a surge of tax scams. It's crucial to remain vigilant during this period.

Remember, the IRS will never request payment through gift cards, electronic funds transfers, money orders, or similar methods. If you feel like you are being scammed, check out irs.gov

#### Welcome to the Town of Gates Assessor's Office.

IMPORTANT: All Basic and Enhanced STAR exemptions must go through New York State. We no longer have those applications. If you have any questions, contact NY State Department of Taxation and Finance at (518) 457-2036.

We offer Limited Income Senior, Limited Income Disability, Veterans, and Volunteer Fire/Ambulance Workers exemptions. These applications are available in our office and on the Town website.

If you are already signed up for, or asked for, our Limited Income Senior or Disability application(s), you should have received them by now. If not, stop in or give us a call. Also, if you are on the Disability program and turning 65 by December 31, 2026, you **MUST** switch to the Senior program. A senior is someone 65 or older, or will be by December 31, 2026. As always, all applications are due by March 1<sup>st</sup>.



#### **GATHER YOUR PAPERWORK!**

We can only accept your 2024 Federal tax return along with all schedules, 1099 and W2 statements. If you do not file a tax return, you must fill out the enclosed Worksheet. When you receive your new or renewal application, you already have the paperwork needed-**2024** tax returns.

The assessor will determine your income after applying the adjustments available in your taxing jurisdictions. Income **does** include taxable IRA distributions. Please read and follow all of the instructions. The income limit tables are included in the application packets.

It's getting close now. Please make sure your get your application(s) in. March  $1^{st}$  is right around the corner, and there are no exceptions to that date.





Be sure to drive by the Hinchey House, to enjoy our outside decorations and winter farm vehicles on display on the front lawn. It is especially beautiful in the evening when the lights come on. If you are still shopping for holiday gifts, check out our gift shop on our website. We have books of local history, Historical Society tee shirts, and (my favorite) maps of Gates from 1872, 1902 and 1924. You can come to the HH to make your purchase or order online. We can ship, although as we get closer we cannot guarantee delivery by Christmas. Give us a call to confirm shipping.
