**AMENDATORY AGREEMENT TO COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR
URBAN COUNTY REQUALIFICATION**

RESOLUTION 149-26

Motion by Supervisor Giunta who moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the Secretary of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, is authorized to make grants to States and units of general local government to help finance Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, and

WHEREAS, the County is an Urban County qualified for participation in the CDBG program for fiscal years 2027 – 2029, and

WHEREAS, the County and the Municipality entered into a Cooperation Agreement on May 6, 2002 (“Cooperation Agreement”), and

WHEREAS, the County and the Municipality wish to amend the Cooperation Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually covenanted and agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. COOPERATION AGREEMENT shall be amended to include 21 c. to read as follows:

c. Parties to this Agreement understand and agree that they may not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer all or any portion of CDBG funds to a Metropolitan City, Urban County, unit of general local government, or insular area that directly or indirectly receives CDBG funds in exchange for any funds, credits, or non-Federal considerations, but must use such funds for activities eligible under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Cooperation Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for the upcoming three-year qualification period term dates: October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2029.
